Chapter 21-Triduum

- ...to present that the Easter Triduum is the Church's greatest celebration of the Paschal Mystery

Chapter 17-Jesus, the Healer

...to emphasize that healing was an important part of Jesus' ministry

...to explain that Jesus gave the Apostles the power to heal others in his name

...to present the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

...to examine ways we can care for those who are sick

Chapter 18-The Celebration of the Anointing of the Sick

...to teach that Jesus is with us when we are suffering

...to explore the meaning of the Sacrament of the
Anointing of the Sick

...to describe the Church's celebration of the Sacrament
of the Anointing of the Sick

...to emphasize that Jesus is with those who hope for eternal life

Chapter 19 – Mary, Model of Discipleship

- ...to explain that Mary was open to God's call
- ...to teach why Mary is the most blessed of women
- ...to explore why Mary is the greatest of all saints
- ...to highlight the way the church honors Mary

Chapter 24-Matrimony: A Promise of Faithfulness and Love

- ...to present the meaning and celebration of the Sacrament of Matrimony
- ...to explain that the marriage covenant is built on Christ's love for the Church
- ...to emphasize that in the Sacrament of Matrimony a man and woman promise always to love and be true to each other
- ...to underscore the importance of families as communities of faith

Chapter 25-Holy Orders: A Promise of Service for the People of God

- ...to present the way in which Jesus shared his ministry with the Apostles
- ...to explain the importance of the Sacrament of Holy Orders
- ...to describe the ways bishops, priests, and deacons serve the Church
- ...to highlight the important elements in the celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Orders

Chapter 26-One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic

- ...to explain that the Church is one and holy
- ...to explore that the Church is catholic and apostolic
- ...to teach that the Church respects all people
- ...to emphasize that the Church works for peace and justice
