

Web Server Personal Photograph Publication Policy

In an effort to prevent anyone from obtaining sufficient information to provide a “profile” (know “when” and where a child would be present at a scheduled event) of a student at St Mary school, the following guidelines are used in regard to publishing personal photographs on the St Mary School Web site:

Children of parents or guardians who do not grant this permission will submit a “Do Not Publish” form and appear on the “Do Not Publish” list maintained by the Principal/Director of Religious Education.

Students will never be identified by name on the “public areas” of the website.

A private, password protected area of the web site may contain the names of students.

One-time events which have already occurred may be published in the “public” areas of the website using photographs of the students.

On-going periodic events, such as standing meetings or sports schedules may be published in the “private area” of the website under password protection.

At the end of a sports season, or at the conclusion of a series of scheduled meetings, photos may be moved from the “private area” to the “public area” of the web site.
